We're a private family beach and sailing club with membership open to the public. Our members come from the greater Jackson, Lansing and Ann Arbor areas and share a love of sailing and socializing. Join us at our clubhouse on beautiful Clark Lake, and meet friendly new people while enjoying the sport of sailing or other lakefront activities.

We offer a unique and affordable opportunity to learn and practice the art of sailing. Originally founded in 1931 as the Royal Bengal Yacht Club to provide an outlet

for sailboat racing enthusiasts who summered on the vacation destination of Clark Lake, our primary mission now is to develop our members' skills in all aspects of sailing. For the beginner, there is the opportunity to crew with experienced skippers as well as formal instruction. For the more advanced, there are Spring and Summer Race Series every Sunday afternoon from May through September.

We are also a great club for those who are looking for a place for the family to enjoy lake shore activities. You don't need to own a boat to join.

Come to Clark Lake and try us out! Your first two visits are free of any charge or obligation. If you're new to sailing, call us and we'll arrange a sample sail with a member. If you're familiar with sailing and want to know more about the club, stop by any weekend to check out the members' fleet and facilities.

### Visiting

When you come out to the club, please bring soft-soled shoes (so as not to damage the surface of members' boats), a towel and change of clothes (in case you get wet!), a lunch (no food is provided at the club although we do have refrigerators available), and drinks. Please, no pets. Life jackets are available at the club in all sizes but feel free to bring your own if you prefer.

### Facilities

Our facilities include: a lakefront clubhouse with meeting room, porch, deck and kitchen; a bath house with bathrooms and changing rooms; and outdoor facilities with a large lawn, barbeque pit, picnic and swimming areas, dock space for 110 boats, both sail and power, plus racks for kayak storage, and a swimming raft. The clubhouse includes two three-bedroom apartments available for members' weekly summer rental.

Our racing fleets consist of member-owned Rebels, Interlakes, Lasers, and Sunfishes. Other classes represented include Hobie 18s and 16s, and Buccaneers. The Club owns several Lasers and Sunfishes for member use.

### Membership
